[4/4 - Britpop acoustic groove] Key: Em

Intro Picking Pattern (simplified for ukulele):

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e | -----0-----0-----0-----0- |
B | ---0-----0-----0-----0--- |
G | -0-----0-----0-----0----- |
C | ----- |
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Repeat through intro on [Em7] and [G].

Intro:

| [Em7] | [G] | [Dsus4] | [A7sus4] | x2

Verse 1:

[Em7] Today is gonna be the day
That they're gonna throw it back to [G] you
[Dsus4] By now you should've somehow
Realized what you gotta [A7sus4] do
[Em7] I don't believe that [G] anybody
[Dsus4] Feels the way I [A7sus4] do about you now

Verse 2:

[Em7] Backbeat, the word was on the street
That the fire in your heart is [G] out
[Dsus4] I'm sure you've heard it all before
But you never really had a [A7sus4] doubt
[Em7] I don't believe that [G] anybody
[Dsus4] Feels the way I [A7sus4] do about you now

Pre-Chorus:

[Cadd9] And all the roads we [Dsus4] have to walk are [Em7] winding
[Cadd9] And all the lights that [Dsus4] lead us there are [Em7] blinding
[Cadd9] There are many [Dsus4] things that I would
[Em7] Like to say to [G] you but I don't know [A7sus4] how

Chorus:

'Cause [Cadd9] maybe
[Dsus4] You're gonna be the one that [Em7] saves me
And [Cadd9] after [Dsus4] all
You're my [Em7] wonderwall

Verse 3:

[Em7] Today was gonna be the day
But they'll never throw it back to [G] you
[Dsus4] By now you should've somehow
Realized what you're not to [A7sus4] do
[Em7] I don't believe that [G] anybody
[Dsus4] Feels the way I [A7sus4] do about you now

Pre-Chorus:

[Cadd9] And all the roads that [Dsus4] lead you there were [Em7] winding
[Cadd9] And all the lights that [Dsus4] light the way are [Em7] blinding
[Cadd9] There are many [Dsus4] things that I would
[Em7] Like to say to [G] you but I don't know [A7sus4] how

Chorus (repeat):

'Cause [Cadd9] maybe
[Dsus4] You're gonna be the one that [Em7] saves me
And [Cadd9] after [Dsus4] all
You're my [Em7] wonderwall

Outro:

| [Em7] | [G] | [Dsus4] | [A7sus4] | fade

Ukulele Tips:

Use a steady down-down-up-up-down-up strum for the verses.
Accent beats 2 and 4 by hitting the lower strings a bit harder.
During the intro, pick the top three strings lightly to mimic the guitar pattern.
Keep it relaxed and flowing – Britpop is about vibe, not perfection.
