**Ukulele Tips:** Chords: \*\*G, C, Em, D\*\* - the classic pop-folk set; easy transitions, big sound.

Keep the rhythm driving with a \*\*down-down-up-up-down-up\*\* strum at around 125 bpm.

Use muted downstrokes or "chucks" on beats 2 and 4 for a percussive stomp effect. Let your voice go — Gerry's not polished, he's passionate. Volume beats perfection here

For the outro, ease off the strumming and let the final G chord ring out like a cheer echoing down Sauchiehall Street.
