Ukulele Tips: Chords: **C, G, Am, F, Em, Dm, A7, B7** — simple shapes, smooth progression.

Use a soft **3/4 waltz rhythm**: *down, down-up, down, down-up* around 65 bpm.


Strum gently near the neck with your thumb for that classic lullaby warmth.

To add sparkle, replace some **C** chords with **Cmaj7** for a dreamy lift.



Let the final C ring out until it fades completely; no rush, just stillness.


