Ukulele Tips: Keep a gentle **down-down-up-up-down-up** or soft fingerpicking (pluck 4-3-2-1) around 100 bpm.

Chords cycle through **D-F#m-G-A** almost the entire way; let them ring clearly.

Stay quiet through the verses, then open the strumming in the outro for warmth.

Let the final **D** chord ring and fade naturally — it's a lullaby ending, not a mic drop.
