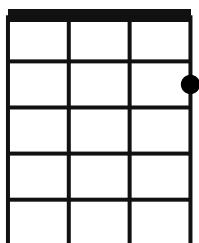
Strumming pattern: ****down-down-up-up-down-up****, soft and syncopated around 90 bpm.

Lean into the rhythm; this one's about groove, not volume.

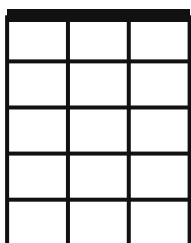
If you want extra warmth, play with your thumb instead of a pick.

Add a cheeky slide from C to Cmaj7 on transitions — it gives that silky, Olivia Dean vibe.

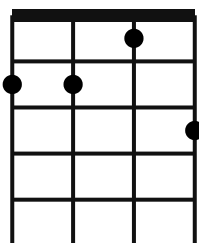
