Strum gently: **down-down-up-up-down-up**, with light chuck mutes for percussion.

Keep tempo around 92 bpm — unhurried, swaying, hypnotic.

Use a low-G uke if you have one; it'll give you that deep, rolling groove.

Sing earnestly — the more sincere you are, the better it lands.

Let the final F chord ring until it feels like the sun's just set over the savanna.
