OUTRO

Ukulele Tips: Chords: **G, C, D, Am** — gentle, classic folk shapes.

Strumming: *down-down-up-up-down-up* or fingerpick strings 4-3-2-1 slowly.

Tempo: ~72 bpm — unhurried, let the silence between chords breathe.

Add soft dynamics — verses quiet, choruses fuller.

Sing close and tender — Donovan's tone was all warmth and understatement.

End on a single open **G** — like a sigh fading into the breeze.
