Ukulele Tips: Chords: **Em, C, G, D, B7** — classic minor-key rock set. Keep a steady, pulsing **down-down-up-up-down-up** at around 95 bpm for that hypnotic drive.

Mute slightly with the side of your palm to emulate the song's tight rhythm section.

Sing half-spoken, half-sung — Matt Johnson's delivery is more storyteller than crooner.

If you've got a low-G uke, use the G string as a faux bassline: alternate open G and 2nd fret for extra depth.

Finish on a slow Em strum — let it hang, bleak and beautiful.
