INTRO

[G] [Em] [C] [D] (x2 – soft and slow, let each chord ring)

VERSE 1

[G] On the day I went away

[Em] Goodbye

[C] Was all I had to **[D]** say

[G] Now I

[Em] I want to come again and **[C]** stay

[D] Oh my, my

VERSE 2

[G] Smile, and that will mean I may

[Em] 'Cause I've seen

[C] Oh, I've seen the blue **[D]** skies

[G] Through the tears in my **[Em]** eyes

[C] And I realise

[D] I'm going **[G]** home

CHORUS

[C] I'm going **[G]** home

[C] I'm going **[G]** home

VERSE 3

[G] Everywhere it's been the same

[Em] Feeling

[C] Like I'm outside in the **[D]** rain

[G] Wheeling

[Em] Free to try and find a **[C]** game

[D] Dealing

VERSE 4

[G] Cards for sorrow, cards for pain

[Em] 'Cause I've seen

[C] Oh, I've seen the blue **[D]** skies

[G] Through the tears in my **[Em]** eyes

[C] And I realise

[D] I'm going **[G]** home

CHORUS

[C] I'm going [G] home

[C] I'm going [G] home

INSTRUMENTAL

[Em] [C] [D] [G] (x2 – soft fingerpicking or slow strum)

BRIDGE

[Am] I'm going home, to [D] start again

[G] Where the people are [Em] kind

And the [C] streets are paved with [D] gold

[Am] Maybe there's peace for a [D] soul like mine

[G] Somewhere [Em] down the [C] line

[D] I'm going [G] home

FINAL CHORUS

[C] I'm going [G] home

[C] I'm going [G] home

OUTRO

[G] [Em] [C] [D] [G]

(Let final chord ring – fade to silence)

Ukulele Tips: Chords: **G, Em, C, D, Am** – all gentle open shapes, easy to blend smoothly.

Strumming: **down-down-up-up-down-up** or single slow downstrokes for a cinematic feel.

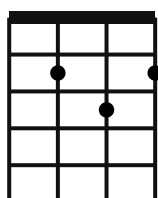
Tempo: ~70 bpm – unhurried, emotional, reflective.

Start with fingerpicking and slowly move into full strums to mirror the song's rising emotion.

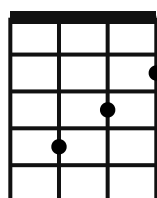
Let each line breathe; the pauses carry as much weight as the notes.

Sing softly and sincerely — this is Frank-N-Furter unmasked, all humanity and hope.

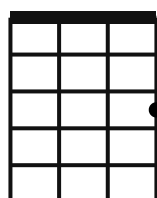

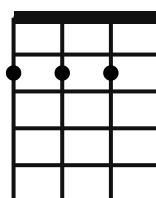

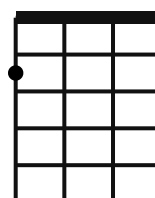
