Ukulele Tips: Chords: **D, G, A7, C, F#m** — bright, jangly, and easy to switch between.

Keep tempo around 100 bpm with a **down-down-up-up-down-up** groove; let it swing naturally.

Add light chuck mutes (palm slaps) on beats 2 and 4 for that acoustic shuffle feel.

To fill space when playing solo, accent the first downstroke in each bar for a subtle bass illusion.

Sing with a half-smile — this is tongue-in-cheek folk-rock cool, not melodrama. End on an open **D** with a playful flourish; that's your mic drop moment.
