Use a steady ****down-down-up-up-down-up**** strum around 95 bpm.

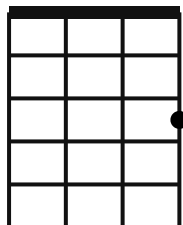
Accentuate the first beat of each bar to mimic the song's rolling momentum.

For a softer vibe, fingerpick 4-3-2-1 and let the melody breathe.

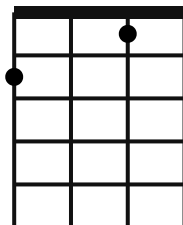
Keep your vocals conversational — Matt Johnson's delivery is reflective, not dramatic.

End on a long, gentle C chord and let it ring like the sunrise after a long night.

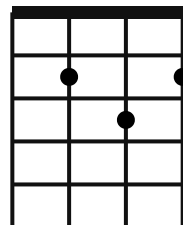

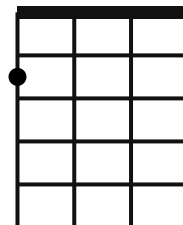
