OUTRO

[Em] [A7] [D] [G] [C7] [B7] [Em] (fade out – sinister chuckle optional)

Ukulele Tips: Chords: **Em, A7, D, G, C7, B7** — jazzy and minor, perfect for that sneaky swing.

Strumming: *down-chuck-up-up-chuck* or soft swing *down-down-up-up-down-up* around 90 bpm.

Mute beats 1 and 3 for that "sneaky villain shuffle."

Add chromatic slides or guick walk-downs (Em \rightarrow D# \rightarrow D) for cartoon flair.

Vocals: go low, gravelly, and theatrical — half-sung, half-spoken.

Pause dramatically before every insult for maximum comedy.

End with a smug smile and a final *Grinchy* chuckle.
